Rather than go on to OCS, however, he volunteered for the draft to minimize his length of service and was fortunate to be assigned to the Counter Intelligence Corps. After training (along with **Al Hoblitzell**) he was sent to Japan and Korea, and ultimately to “real tough duty” at Scofield Barracks in Hawaii. Steve’s military experience was positive and he is a believer in mandatory military or community service for all.
