Dear Class Representative,

I am pleased to share with you the enclosed report on the Class associated scholarship for the 2014-15 academic year. We have also asked the students to write directly to their sponsors—either to the class as a whole or to an individual associated with the class—about themselves and their own Princeton experiences.

This year we expect to award approximately \$130M in need-based financial aid to 59% of our undergraduates, or approximately 3,100 students. The average financial aid package is \$44,100, made up of \$42,000 in grant aid and \$2,100 from a campus job. Most importantly, 81% of the awards will come from endowed Princeton scholarships.

Princeton can be justifiably proud not only of its commitment to financial aid but also of the fact that so many members of the Princeton family have made these awards possible. Your support of our students through our aid program is greatly appreciated. Please accept my thanks on behalf of the current recipients.
