

**Howard H. McClure, Jr.** was born in Lancaster, Pennsylvania, and came to Princeton from Middletown High School. He was on the Freshman and Sophomore Council and was Executive Secretary and Vice Chairman of the Undergraduate Council. He served on the Honor Committee, the Elections Committee, and was Director of the Campus Blood Drive. After graduation Howard went to the University of Rochester School of Medicine for his medical degree and then was a student fellow in the Department of Pathology. He was an Intern and Resident at the V.A. Hospital and Parkland Memorial Hospital in Dallas, Texas, from 1958 to 1961. After serving as a Research Fellow in the Department of Physiology at Dartmouth Howard went into private practice in internal medicine and cardiology in Dallas. He was an honorary member and past president of the Texas Heart Association. Howard died on March 30, 2017. He is survived by his wife, Wynona, and his three children and nine grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
