

James Edward Green was born in Mobile, Alabama, but moved to Atlanta at the age of ten where he graduated from Henry Grady High. At Grady, he was elected student body president and was captain of the school's first football team. At Princeton Jim majored in Economics, was a member of Cap and Gown, and served as class president. Following college, he served two years in the U S Army Artillery before returning to Atlanta with the rank of First Lieutenant. Jim joined Citizens and Southern National Bank in 1955 and advanced over the next twenty-five years to the position of General Vice President and member of the Executive Committee before forming his own company, J. E. Green and Company, to provide loan review services for community banks in the Southeast and throughout the Midwest. Jim retired from business in 2003 and in the following years summered at his mountain home in Highlands, NC. Jim enjoyed sports and loved golf all of his life.. He once said, "I like everything about the game but the score." Jim's wife of 45 years, Nancy, died in 2003 and Jim died in Atlanta on September 25, 2017. He is survived by two children, Lyle and Cynthia, and two grandchildren.
