

Glenn Gabell Anderson, who died on January 19, 2019, was born in Cleveland and came to Princeton from Cleveland Heights High School. He majored in Mechanical Engineering, belonged to the Marching Band and Concert Band and sang in the Varsity Glee Club. He was a member of Cannon Club. After graduating, Glenn attended Officer Candidate School at the U.S. Coast Guard Academy and then guarded first the North Atlantic coast and then Caribbean and Alaskan waters before moving on to the Harvard Business School to earn an M.B.A. in 1957. Returning to the Cleveland area Glenn held various positions with the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, then with Ohio Machinery Co., Western Reserves Resources Corp., and finally the Cleveland Trust Company as a vice president and senior trust officer. Glenn was always actively involved in his church and a number of other volunteer societies, but especially the Boy Scouts of America, who honored his service with the Silver Beaver and Silver Antelope awards. He was also a Trustee of the United Way and the Cleveland Rotary Club. Glenn was predeceased by his wife, Marcella, who attended our fiftieth reunion with him a few months before her death. He is survived by sons Glenn and Robert and daughter Marcella, as well as five grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
